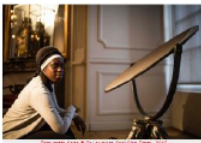

Space for a Sustainable World - Women in Action :

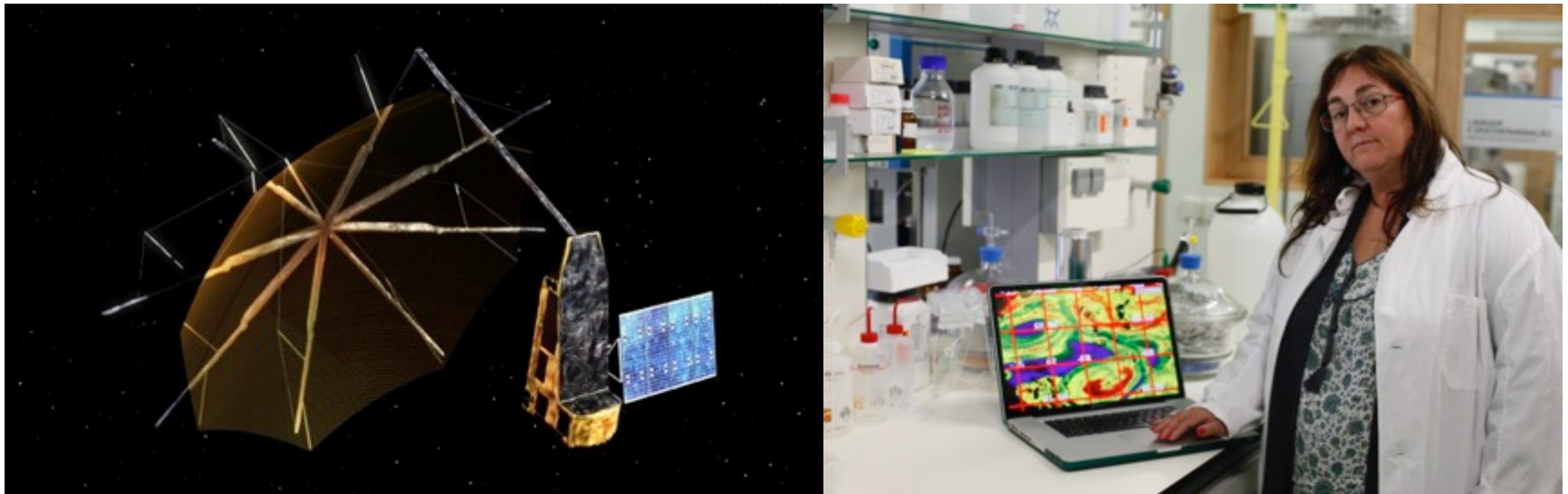

technologies such as:

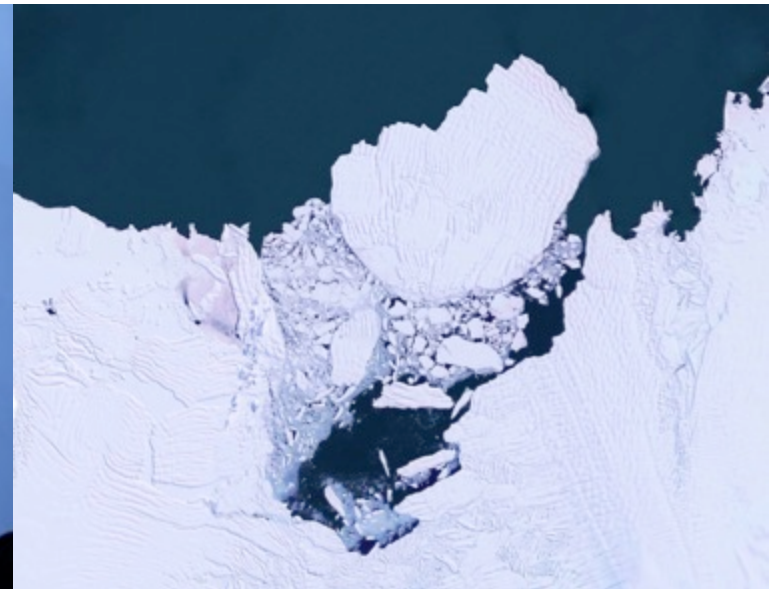
- Earth observation and remote sensing

Whether scientists or users of space technology, each will become her country's ambassador in the promotion of women's involvement in space activities and girls' interest in the sciences in general.

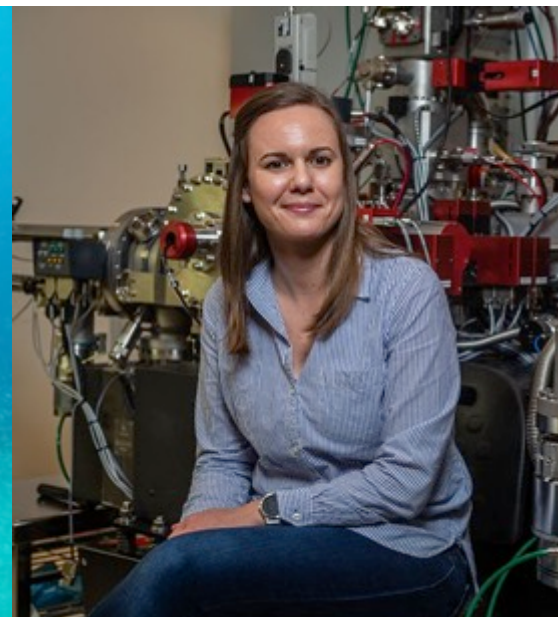


The portraits of women will look at the concrete applications of spatial activities in the areas covered by the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):
